







WORKSHOP - WET FELTED FLOWERS WITH BEADED CENTERS

Description:

We'll make easy very colorful flowers with a little wool roving, soap and water, I'll show you every step for a few different styles. Then we will do some easy and fast beadweaving centers (you could also use these for earring or pendants) that look like you spent hours. Two fun techniques in one class, with so many possibilities! Bet you can't make just one!

Starred items are included in optional kit:

Hand towel, sharp scissors

- *two pieces of small bulbbles bubble wrap 12 x 12
- *fine tulle 16" square or nylon netting
- *container for water
- *dish soap
- *sponge
- *6 colors of wool for wet felting (Merino wool roving or Corriedale) 19-23 microns (.5 oz each max)
- *3 colors of short fiber MC-1 batt
- *silk, bamboo, viscose roving, curly locks, sari silk waste, silk hankies, angelina fibers,
- *wool, cotton, silk yarn
- *Big eye quilting needle
- *Fireline or similar beading thread
- *6 dozen different two hole beads, twins, gingko, also a dozen square beads, 6 mm round,
- *4 mm t round, crystal bicones, size 8 and 11 sead beads
- *pin back
